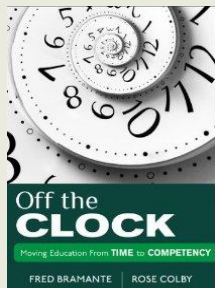


The NATIONAL CENTER for COMPETENCY-BASED LEARNING
